


HOW TO STOP BLADES COMING OFF PULLEYS

- 1. Don't align pulleys to the shaft. The pulleys are meant to be offset.
- 2. The top pulley is meant to be on an angle. If the blade is coming off the top pulley more angle needs to be added.
- 3. To achieve this there is a small screw sunken just below the top bearing shaft in the top bearing block. Usually this needs 1 or 2 turns clockwise which will allow the blade to run in the centre of the pulley.
- 4. See the diagram below of the angle setting.
